



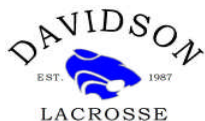
**Stixx Club Meeting

- Coach Godwin said that with a new coach you can expect changes. He took the boys out separately to meet with them to go over expectations. He asked the parents to review the packet he handed out with their sons.
- Mulch sale is the Stixx Clubs only fund raiser. Our goal is to earn \$23,000. Call list will be distributed so players can call people who have purchased mulch in the past. Boys are strongly encouraged to take the 4 day weekend to get their bags sold. Players were given complete mulch sale packets. Sales begin immediately. Any additional sales materials are available on the website.
- Canvassing will be done March 8. The boys will spend 5 hours on the Saturday afternoon selling in specific neighborhoods. They will meet at the school at 9:00 a.m. and be done at 2:00 p.m.
- Mulch Day food. A sign up sheet for providing food and working the food table will be available at Meet the Team Night.
- Meet the Team Night will be held March 17 at 7:00 p.m. Everyone is asked to bring a meat casserole and a side dish to share. The website will give a list of what each class is asked to bring.
- Game Day Food. The Stixx Club will provide food for teams that travel a long distance to play Davidson. Food will only be provided for about 3 teams.

- Programs. Stixx Club contracted with a company to produce programs. They will sell all of the advertising and assume printing cost. We will get any profits from the sell of the programs at the game. Tom Baker is handling the coordination.
- Senior Posters. Kathy Maynard will be in charge of the Senior Poster,.
- Scholarship. Stixx Club provides 2 scholarships to outgoing seniors. \$1000 and \$500 awarded at the end of the year banquet. Terri Roberts is heading the committee. The \$500 scholarship is voted on by players for most inspirational player and named in memory of Michael Breschi, the son of Ohio State's Lacrosse coach.
- Spring Trip. Varsity team will travel Wednesday, March 26 to Covington, Kentucky for a game. They will travel to Louisville on Thursday for a game and return home. It will be one overnight. The Stixx Club will provide for all the expenses on the trip.
- Spirit Wear. Betty Winland handles the spirit wear. It is left over from last year and we will not be getting any additional inventory.
- Stats. A chairperson is needed for freshmen, JV and Varsity. Parents are in charge of keeping stats. Pam Chilovich is willing to help but needs a 3 people willing to take over the committee. 3 parents are needed for each home game and 2 for away games. The committee chairs will be responsible for the scheduling of the parents. No previous experience necessary.
- Website. Deb Hohn is setting up the new website. davidsonlax.com. It is currently under construction.
- Budget. Susie Loesch.
- Susie went over 2007 Financial Statement and our projected cost for 2008.
- Stixx Club dues of \$35 are required to be a member. Checks can be made payable to Stixx Club and given to any officer or mailed to Susie Loesch, 5330 Cee Court, Hilliard, 43026. Only members of the Stixx Club are eligible to vote.
